Seth joined the Hermeus team in 2023 as an Aerospace Engineer and Commercial Pilot with eight years of experience in the emerging technology UAS industry. Prior to joining Hermeus, Seth served as the Senior Systems Engineer and Corporate Pilot at Phoenix Air Group. In this role, he led UAS payload integration, managed government business development, and secured the unmanned department's first federal contract with the Department of Energy. Additionally, Seth supported regulatory approval efforts that resulted in the first nationwide UAS beyond visual line of sight exemption and COA, as well as the SAC-EC and operating exemption for the 192 lb. SwissDrones SDO 50 V2.

Since joining Hermeus in 2023, Seth has held both engineering and programmatic roles, including Responsible Engineer of the Quarterhorse Mk 1 flight termination system's build and certification, corporate pilot, and flight test systems engineer. He currently leads Hermeus' civil approval efforts, which have enabled the first civil supersonic UAS operations of the Quarterhorse Mk 2 aircraft.
